

how to do a cutout:

1. Open the image in **Photoshop**.
2. Display **Path Palette** (**Window > Path**).
3. Choose the **Magic Wand** tool from the Toolbox.
4. Click on the background of the image. If there is space that is not selected, hold shift and use the **Magic Wand** tool to cover that area.
5. Once all of the background is selected, go to **Select > Inverse**. This should display a dotted line around the object that you are cutting out.
6. Make a work path by clicking the arrow on the top right of the Path Palette and selecting **Make Work Path**.
7. Set Tolerance to 0.5 and click OK.
8. In the Palette Options window, save your path. Select **Save Path** and name your path. Click OK.
9. Use the same arrow on the path palette one more time to select **Clipping Path**.
10. Change path to the name of the new path. Change the flatness to 9 and click OK.
11. Save your image.
12. The image can now be placed into a frame in **Adobe InDesign**.
